




# **Lyon Hall—Suites**

# **Substance Free Living:**

Student Housing at NCC is Substance Free

(Possession and use of alcohol and illegal drugs is prohibited in student housing. Alcohol possession and consumption is not allowed even if a student is 21 or older. NCC's student housing is also tobacco free.)

#### **Resident Assistants:**

There are Resident Assistants (RAs) in each Hall to support fellow student residents. They are a resource to residents having questions, concerns, or personal issues.

## **Community Assistant:**

Our student housing has a Community Assistant (CA) who plans recreation and social activities for residents.

## **Expectations:**

Mutual respect and consideration for each other's space and property is expected at all times within the student housing community. Behaviors which demean, threaten, or harm another person or another's rights or property will not be tolerated. Residents who demonstrate inappropriate behaviors and infringe upon other's property, including NCC property, will be asked to leave.

# **Housing Application Timeline:**

The best time to apply for housing in both units is as soon as possible. Students often send their Student Housing Application/Contract soon after they apply for admission at NCC. Students are assigned in sequence determined by the date that the signed application/contract and application fee are received.
